Title: Junior Field Staff

Job Description: North Branch Nature Center is seeking a qualified individual to be a Junior Field Staff member for campers ages 4 to 11 during our 2019 summer camp season. The position will be responsible for acting as an assistant to the summer camp instructors in activities such as group games, arts and crafts, sensory awareness activities, nature exploration activities, and forest choice time. Assisting with overall supervision, gathering/putting away supplies, participating in activities as appropriate for a helper (role modeling), and aiding children in preparing for activities (sunscreen, water bottles, tying shoes, etc.) will also be part of their role. Junior Field Staff will receive on the job training with experienced full time staff. As a staff member at NBNC, this person will hold a position of great responsibility and importance to the success of the program. Their warmth, enthusiasm, and sensitivity to the needs of each camper profoundly influences each day of camp. We are looking for someone who can fulfill these criteria, but who also has a genuine love for nature and the outdoors.

- Be patient, energetic, fun-loving, hardworking, and have a sense of humor.
- Maintain a positive and appropriate attitude.
- Be willing and able to put the needs of others before your own.
