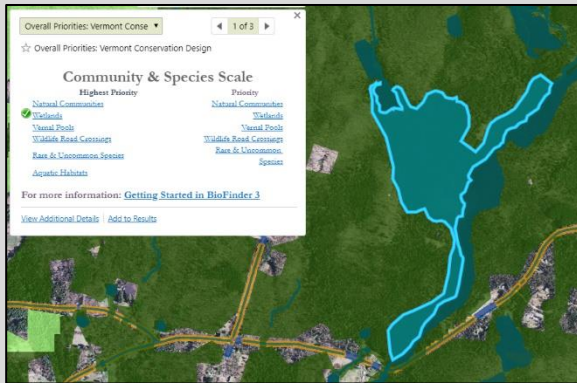
What Is BioFinder?

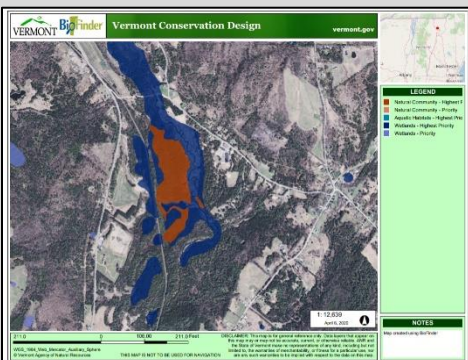
